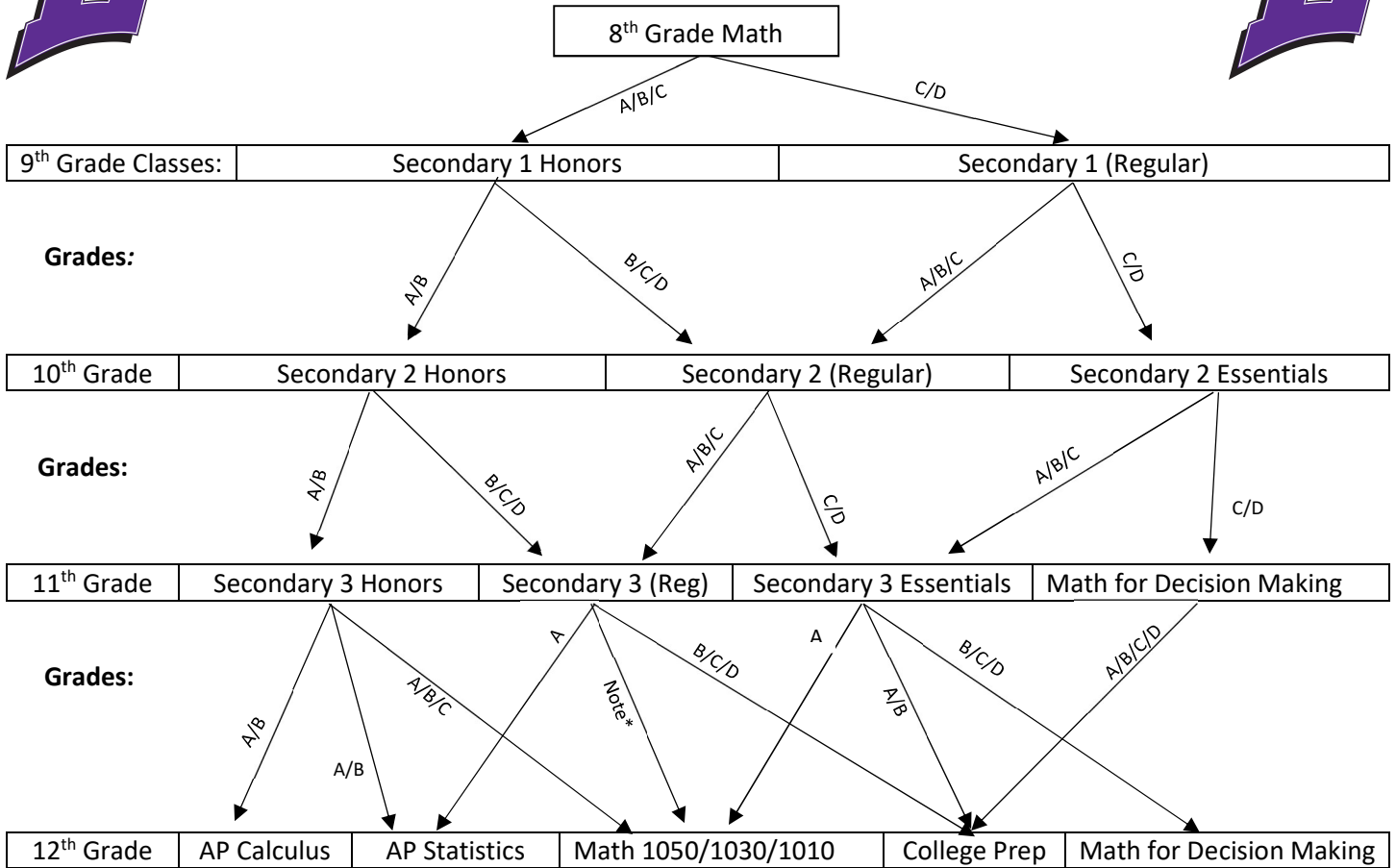




LHS Mathematical Flow Chart



Notes:

- Although 3 years of math is required for graduation, 4 years of math is highly recommended for college readiness.
- Students who are a year ahead of this schedule should take AP Statistics their Senior year.
- AP Statistics may be taken after, instead of, or concurrently with AP Calculus, Math 1050.
- Math 1050 is a concurrent enrollment class with UVU and is worth 4 hrs. college credit. Math 1030/1010 is worth 3.
 - To qualify for Math 1050 you must have an ACT Math score of 23+ **and** a "C" average from Sec. 1, 2, & 3.
 - To qualify for Math 1030 you must have an ACT Math score of 23+ **or** a "C" average from Sec. 1, 2, & 3.
 - To qualify for Math 1010 you must have an ACT Math score of 19+ **or** a "C" average from Sec. 1, 2, & 3.
- **Honors classes** are encouraged as they provide students the best preparation for the ACT and university classes.
- For students not in honors, regular classes are recommended.
- Going from a regular class to an honors class requires teacher approval.
- The **Essential classes** will cover essential topics to provide basic math skills for struggling students. Teacher approval.
- **Math for Decision Making (MDM)** is a practical math class not designed for college preparation. *Students need an "Opt-Out of Secondary 3" form signed by a parent in order to take MDM.*
- Students with registration questions should talk to their math teacher.
